

## Young Scientists PHOTOVOICE Competition (Call for Submissions)

The College of the Early Career Scientists (CESC) of the International Union of Food Science and Technology and International Academy of Food Science and Technology (IUFoST/IAFoST) is accepting submissions for the Young Scientists Photovoice Competition as a part of our second international symposium with the theme: *Food innovations in a post-pandemic world*.

This year's symposium focuses on innovation opportunities in food product and process development in the aftermath of the COVID pandemic. Important discussions shall highlight the role of innovation to ensure a healthy and safe food supply as well as to attain a more sustainable and food secure environment. The aim of this photovoice competition is to encourage participation from young scientists to advocate for food innovative ideas that will shape the post-pandemic world.

We invite undergraduate and postgraduate students in agriculture, food science, nutrition, and related fields to participate in this competition. Submissions will be assessed by an international team of judges based on the following criteria:

- Relevance to the Symposium Theme (Composition & Content) 40%
- How innovative the proposed idea is (20%)
- Creativity (20%)
- Overall artistic and visual impression (20%)

The symposium will be held virtually on **September 28, 2023, at 07:00 am - 09:00 am** (Eastern Standard Time). Top finalists will be featured and winners will be announced during the symposium.

## **Mechanics**:

The theme is *Food innovations in a post-pandemic world*. Your photovoice must address reflect on the question - *What is the innovation(s) required in a post-pandemic global food system to ensure a more sustainable and food-secure environment?* Your proposed innovation must address one or more of the four pillars of food security: availability, access, utilization, and stability.

The photovoice entry should contain a video commentary of not more than 3 minutes explaining the context of the photograph in relation to the theme.

and related fields.
<ul> <li>Group submission is not allowed. An individual can submit only 1 entry.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Entries must not contain material that is inappropriate, indecent, obscene,</li> </ul>
hateful, tortious, defamatory, slanderous, or libelous.
<ul> <li>Entries must not contain brand names, logos, trademarks, and the like of a third</li> </ul>
parties.
