Terms & Conditions

Terms of Payment

On receipt of the completed form, a confirmation email with invoice for payment will be sent to the sponsor.

- All invoices must be paid within 14 days of the invoice date. If the payment is not received, the sponsorship may be sold to other organizations.
- Payment can be settled by bank wire transfer, Visa, Mastercard. All bank charges are the responsibility of the sender. If the sponsor fails to submit full payment before June 30, 2026, the Congress organizer can cancel their participation in IUFoST 2026.

Bank transfer

Bank transfer information will be provided on the invoice.

Cancellation with Refund

- Should a sponsor wish to cancel any of its participation, written notification must be sent to sponsor@IUFoST2026.org.
- Before May 25, 2026, the sponsorship fee is refundable minus a 25% charge.
- After May 25, 2026, no refund will be available.
- All refunds are subject to a deduction of applicable banking service fees, which shall be borne by the sponsor/exhibitor.

Amendments to General Terms & Conditions

All matters not covered in these regulations, in general Terms & Conditions, or in other IUFoST2026 publications are subject to the decision and control of the Congress organizers. The Congress organizers reserve the right to take such actions and make such changes, including amendments to the "Terms & Conditions," as are considered necessary or desirable for the efficient and proper conduct of the Congress.

The Congress organizers reserve the right, in unforeseen circumstances, to amend or alter the exact site or location of the booth, and the exhibitor undertakes to accept any alterations to the site or space reallocated by the Congress organizers. Any matters not specifically covered by the preceding Terms & Conditions shall be subject solely to the decision of the organizers.

These Terms & Conditions may be amended at any time by the Congress organizers, and all such amendments shall be binding on sponsors equally with the foregoing Terms & Conditions. Exhibitors must have public liability insurance for the duration of the exhibition. The Local Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any loss or injury that may occur to the exhibitor, the exhibitor's employees, delegates, or property from any cause whatsoever, prior to, during, or after the Conference. Exhibitors shall indemnify and hold harmless the Local Organizing Committee from all liability (damage or accident) that

might arise from any cause related to or connected with the transportation, placement, removal, or display of exhibits.

In the event that the Congress cannot be held or must be changed due to circumstances beyond the control of the Congress organizers (force majeure), or due to events not attributable to any wrongful intent or gross negligence on the part of the Congress organizers, the Congress organizers cannot be held liable for any damages, costs, or losses that may be incurred, such as transportation costs, accommodation costs, financial losses, etc.

Booth Allocation / Eligibility for Exhibition

Booth Selection and Allocation

1. Booth selection priority is determined by the number of booths reserved, with exhibitors reserving more booths given priority.
 2. If the number of booths is the same, priority will be determined by the total sponsorship amount.
 3. If both are the same, priority will be determined by the order of payment receipt.
 4. The Organizer reserves the right to make the final determination and to adjust the booth allocation process as necessary due to operational or logistical considerations.
- If exhibitors request raw space, please note that raw space is priced the same as a standard booth, and standard booth items will not be provided. For custom-designed stands, please provide a diagram of the proposed booth with details and dimensions. All display constructions require the approval of the IUFOST 2026 Congress Secretariat before the deadline specified in the exhibitor manual.
 - The Congress organizers reserve the right to alter the layout of the exhibition area, remove sections or features (such as poster or refreshment areas), or change the venue and date of the exhibition under certain circumstances. Exhibitors/Sponsors will be notified of any changes in advance. Any change in booth location does not entitle the Exhibitor/Sponsor to cancel the exhibition space or claim monetary compensation.

Sponsors/Exhibitors must follow the standard criteria that only products and services related to the topic of the Congress may be presented. The distribution of promotional materials is limited to the Sponsors'/Exhibitors' rented area. Signs and banners at the booths must be directly related to the name of the Sponsor/Exhibitor.

- Sponsors/Exhibitors agree to be present for the full duration of the exhibition during the Congress. Setup and dismantling of any stands must occur only during the specifically allotted times.
- All detailed exhibition rules and regulations will be provided in the exhibitor manual.
- All exhibitors participating in IUFOST 2026 are required to register online. A registered badge will be required to access the exhibition area.
